

PLANTING

SMALL TREES WITH UNDERPLANTING IN ORNAMENTAL POTS



1 What do I need? Ornamental pots, plants, clay granules and potting compost.



2 First, place a thick layer of clay granules in the bottom of the pots; this makes them lighter.



3 Then add a layer of potting compost, clay granules prevent potting compost from being washed away with the water.



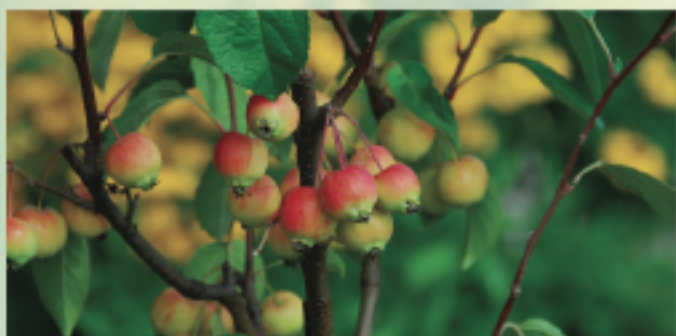
4 There is space below a shrub or small tree to grow low plants.



5 First place the shrub or small tree in the ornamental pot, and then place the low plants around it.



6 Fill the space between the rootballs with potting compost.



7 Water immediately, and thereafter water regularly.



8 The potting compost provides sufficient nutrients for around 6 weeks, after which you need to feed.
