

PLANTING

CONIFERS (WITH ROOTBALL)



1 Dig a planting hole with a circumference greater than the rootball.



2 Dig in plenty of compost to enrich the soil in the planting hole.



3 Place the conifer with wrapped rootball in the planting hole.



4 Cut off the sacking.



5 Pull the sacking from under the rootball.



6 Fill in the planting hole with soil.



7 Carefully firm down the soil around the rootball.



8 Water well, and continue to do so if the weather remains dry.
