

PLANTING

CLIMBING PLANTS



1 Dig a planting hole 20 to 25 cm from the trellis.



2 Dig in plenty of compost to enrich the soil in the planting hole.



3 Remove the climbing plant from the pot.



4 Place the climbing plant slanting next to the trellis.



5 Fill up the planting hole with soil so that the growth point is placed below the surface.



6 With a *Clematis* the base of the plant is protected from the sun by planting low plants in front of it.



7 Detach the tendrils from the cane and tie them to the trellis.



8 Water well, and continue to do so if the weather remains dry.
