

PRUNING (MARCH-APRIL)

ORNAMENTAL GRASSES



1 Ornamental grasses still lend shape to the border in winter.



2 After the winter the foliage is completely brown and dead.



3 Underneath all this dead foliage there are enough green grass stems to grow vigorously in the spring.



4 Push aside the dead foliage with one hand.



5 The dead foliage can then be cut off with the other hand.



6 The entire tussock is thus pruned evenly.



7 The young fresh stems now have light and space to grow rapidly.



8 Ornamental grasses can be combined beautifully in a border with perennials.
