

PRUNING (MARCH AND AUGUST)

LAVENDER



1 In order to prevent lavender from becoming woody, you need to prune it in time.



2 This will result in as many branches at the base as possible.



3 The main pruning occurs after the winter at the end of March.



4 We then prune the plant back by about 1/3rd. Not to the bare part.



5 The summer pruning occurs after flowering in August.



6 Only cut back the dead flower stems and stem tops.



7 The plant then has the chance to grow a little before winter comes.



8 This means that the plant retains its compact shape.
